Baylands Family Credit Union (BFCU) is a proud participant of CO-OP Shared Branching! As a BFCU member, Shared Branching gives you the ability to do a range of transactions at any one of the more than 5,000+ participating credit unions across the nation.

What is Shared Branching?

Shared Branching is a network of credit unions across the country that actually "share" branches. If you are a member of a participating credit union, you can conduct transactions at any branch within the network. These branches are identified by the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo.

Where are Shared Branches?

Shared Branches are where YOU are! Thousands of Shared Branches are located across the United States as well as some international locations. There is no need to worry if college, business, or a weekend getaway has taken you away from your home credit union location. No matter the reason, you can make real-time transactions at any participating branch. There is almost always a Shared Branching location nearby. Just look for the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo.

How do I locate a shared branch?

BFCU is here to help you locate a Shared Branching location anytime, anywhere. Check out the locator search on your BFCU Mobile App or by visiting our website at: baylandsfcu.org/about-us/locations

How does it work?

Simply stop in any credit union that displays the CO-OP Shared Branching Logo. When performing a transaction at a Shared Branch, remember to provide the following:

- Your home credit union's name
- Your account number
- A valid government-issued photo I.D., such as a state driver's license or U.S. passport

Is it easy to use?

Yes. Using a Shared Branch is just as easy to use as using your home credit union.

What transactions or services are available?

You can conduct the following transactions at any Shared Branch:

- Cash/Check deposits¹
- Cash/Check withdrawals²
- Extended hours of access
- Loan payments
- Transfers between Sub-Accounts
- Transfers between Shared Branching Credit Unions
- 10 Day transaction printouts
- Purchase money orders³
- Purchase travelers checks³
- Purchase official checks³
